


Village of Oostburg, WI

The Village provides the public water system, sewer, and wastewater utility services.

Landline phone service is provided by Verizon north. Time Warner provides broadband services.

TRANSPORTATION

The Village of Oostburg is located along Interstate-43 and County Roads A, AA, and K. Rail access is proved by the Union Pacific Railroad (UP). Sheboygan County Memorial Airport (SMB) is 16 miles away.

HOUSING

Using 2000 Census data, the median housing value in the Village was \$113,200 and is higher than the median housing value of the entire County.

BUSINESS PARKS

The 140-acre Village of Oostburg Business Park is located adjacent to Interstate 43. The Village owns and marketing 85 acres for development both north and south of County Highway AA (Center Avenue). The lot lines can be configured to suit the buyer's needs. The Park is ideal for light -industrial, warehousing, distribution or for professional, medical and corporate office facilities in an affordable high visibility setting. Improved lots are available and ready for facility construction. The Oostburg Business Park is a prime location for companies seeking to lower costs of doing business.
