


Town of Lyndon, WI

ECONOMIC PROFILE

The Town of Lyndon is located in west central Sheboygan County. The Town of Lyndon is defined by its vast farmlands, woodlands, open spaces and natural resources. The Town surrounds the Villages of Cascade and Waldo. The Town directs residential, commercial, and industrial growth in a reasonable fashion that discourages urban sprawl, but allows landowners a variety of land uses on their property. The Town is home to Lake Ellen.

LABOR FORCE

In 2000, the Town had 863 residents in the labor force. In March of 2010, Sheboygan County has a total of 63,379 people in the labor force and an unemployment rate of 10.0%.

UTILITIES

WATER & SEWER

The Town of Lyndon does not have a public water system. Residents within the Town have wells. The Town of Lyndon currently has a sanitary district located around Lake Ellen and pumps waste into the sewer system of the Village of Cascade. Also, a small portion of the Village of Hingham sanitary districts is located in the southeastern portion of the Town. The remainder of the residents of the Town are responsible for installing and maintaining their own individual septic systems.

TELECOMMUNICATIONS

Landline phone service is provided by Verizon North. Broadband internet is offered by Time Warner Cable where available.

TRANSPORTATION

The Town is intersected by State Highway 28 and 57. Rail service is provided by the Wisconsin and Southern Rail Company (WSOR). Sheboygan County Memorial Airport (SMB) is 13 miles away.

HOUSING

Using 2000 Census data, the median housing value in the Village was \$125,300 and is lower than the median housing value of the entire County.

BUSINESS PARKS

Currently there are no business parks in the Town of Lyndon. As the Town of Lyndon does not have public water and has limited sewer, large business and industrial growth is better suited for other areas, such as the Villages of Cascade and Waldo. Commercial development may occur, but will need good visibility and access, and meet the Town's community character.

INCOME

The Town's median household income in 1999 was \$56,121, which was higher than the State and Federal median household income.
